STUDENT EXEMPTION OF REGISTERED LINE TECHNICIANS

The Louisiana Behavior Analyst Board [Board] opines that line technician applicants are exempt from registering with the board if they are in accordance with BOTH of the following requirements.

- 1) Enrolled in a matriculated college or university student, intern, or postdoctoral fellow whose activities are part of a defined behavior analysis program of study, supervised field or clinical experience

AND

- 2) The experience is conducted under the extended authority of the university faculty member assigned to the course and is also supervised by a LBA.

Applicants who only fulfill one of the above two requirements, must register with the Board.
